### Public Forum on East Montpelier Village Master Plan

The Chair gave some background on the village plan, an overview of the plan and why the PC is working on the plan. Ms. Potter reviewed the vision statement, the subareas and minimum lot sizes and the buildout analysis. Ms. Potter also reviewed the fourteen action items. The Chair reviewed the next steps for the PC, which includes another forum in September or October on the final draft. Questions and Comments:

- Will a wastewater system be addressed? The PC noted that it is being addressed and the Old LaPerle Farm property may be a possible solution. Shared systems and small community systems will be encouraged. There was some discussion regarding the Crystal Springs water system that covers most of the village but doesn't have capacity right now.
- Will a village green/pocket park be included? The PC noted the green in front of the church. A river walk behind the station would be desirable. The Old LaPerle Farm property committee is looking at utilizing the built-in green space.

#### Likes/Dislikes about the plan:

- Like the spirit of the plan, appreciate the layers of planning
- ➤ Like the sense of place, it's exciting
- Like the walk & bike-friendly sense and the connectivity; the PC noted the new sidewalks planned and the new Park N Ride facility
- > Concern would like to have a reason to come to the village, but concerned with the increase in taxes and cost of living due to smaller lots; the Town Administrator noted that taxes are not based on property being sub dividable
