PC discussed possible revisions to zoning regulations including these sections:

- ➤ 6.6 (A) drop reference to section 1403 and revise to "chapter 17."
- > 7.8 (A)(1) drop "DRB" and add "PC"
- > Table 1.1 under site plan approval change text to "Conditional uses require site plan approval."
- ➤ 3.13 (C) make as 2 sentences as below:
- ➤ "In any district, junk, salvage materials and or 3 or more vehicles or portions thereof which are non-operating and not registered with the state, shall be stored in an enclosed area or in an area concealed from public roads and neighboring residential properties. Vehicles or materials used for farming or forestry operations are exempt."
- ➤ 3.14 PC agreed no changes need to be made to this section concerning setback waivers.
- ➤ 6.1 (B) add new paragraph to exemptions:
- "(5) Two or more adjoining lots owned by the same entity can be merged through a boundary adjustment. All mergers must be issued a zoning permit in accordance with Section 7.3 and also be subject to plat recording requirements under Section 6.6."
