Discussion with Lt. Paul White, Vermont State Police; Consideration of 2013 State Police Contract

Lt. White gave the SB a handout with the incident report for 2012; the report shows that EM is the 3rd busiest town covered by the 3rd busiest barracks in the state. The calls to North Street have diminished since last year. The contract is nearing its end (3/31/13) and the new contract has an increase of \$1500 from last year. The Middlesex barracks has a high turnover rate which Lt. White ascribed to understaffing and consequent high workload.

Road Foreman Report

The SB should review Road & Bridge Standards document prior to the next meeting and be ready to discuss. Many town signs are non-compliant and need to be replaced; Kim Swasey will call Edie Miller to see if the SignPost would like to use the old signs as a fundraiser. There was a discussion of the slowdown of replacements and looking at the wooden ones first; also existing metal poles need to be breakaway. Regarding the Sawyer property, there was a water issue caused by a blocked culvert and Mike has corrected the problem.

Consideration of Revolving Loan Fund Advisory Committee Recommendation to Loan Funds to EMSLI

The SB is comfortable with moving forward on loaning funds to the East Montpelier Senior Living Initiative (EMSLI).

Town Treasurer Report

The smaller accounts have now been combined into the main account. The Treasurer plans to move \$50,000 from checking to the Capital Reserve Fund.

Farm Contract Extensions

The SB will let the contracts run through to their ends, but will extend the contracts that expire 3/31/13, so the affected landowners may apply to Current Use before 9/1/13 for next year.
