2006 CHANGES TO PROPERTY TAXES

At the 2005 Town Meeting, East Montpelier voters authorized the change of the Town's budgeting year from a calendar year to a fiscal year starting July 1 and ending June 30. Tax payments for a provisional 6-month budget are due on March 15, 2007. In 2006, the voters authorized that annual taxes be collected in two installments (November 15 and May 15) starting in the fall of 2007.
