

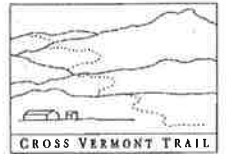

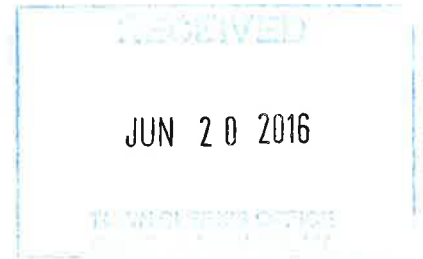

Hello Town of East Montpelier,

This year's Central Vermont Cycling Tour (CVCT) is scheduled for June 26, 2016. Started as the EcoTour in 2002, this is the 14th running of the tour. CVCT is a fun, low key, family event and an attraction for tourists visiting our area. It's also a charity fundraiser - helping to raise money for the Cross Vermont Trail Association. The tour highlights some of the great, scenic roads in your town - thank you!

CVCT utilizes public roads in the towns of East Montpelier, Calais, Woodbury, Middlesex and Worcester. There are 3 different rides of approximately 15, 30, and 60 miles in length. Route maps are enclosed. As in past years, we will be putting up directional signs and arrows the day before the ride, Saturday June 25, and removing them the evening of June 26.

Every participant in the event will sign a waiver indemnifying each of the towns through which the ride passes. The event and all landowners, including towns, are covered by Cross Vermont Trail Association's Commercial General Liability insurance policy (\$2,000,000 limit). Coverage is through Federal Insurance Company, c/o Chantilly-Alliant Ins Svc Inc, 4530 Walney Rd Ste 200, Chantilly, VA 20151-2285. Green Mountain Bike Patrol will be on site to provide coordination and assistance to participants.

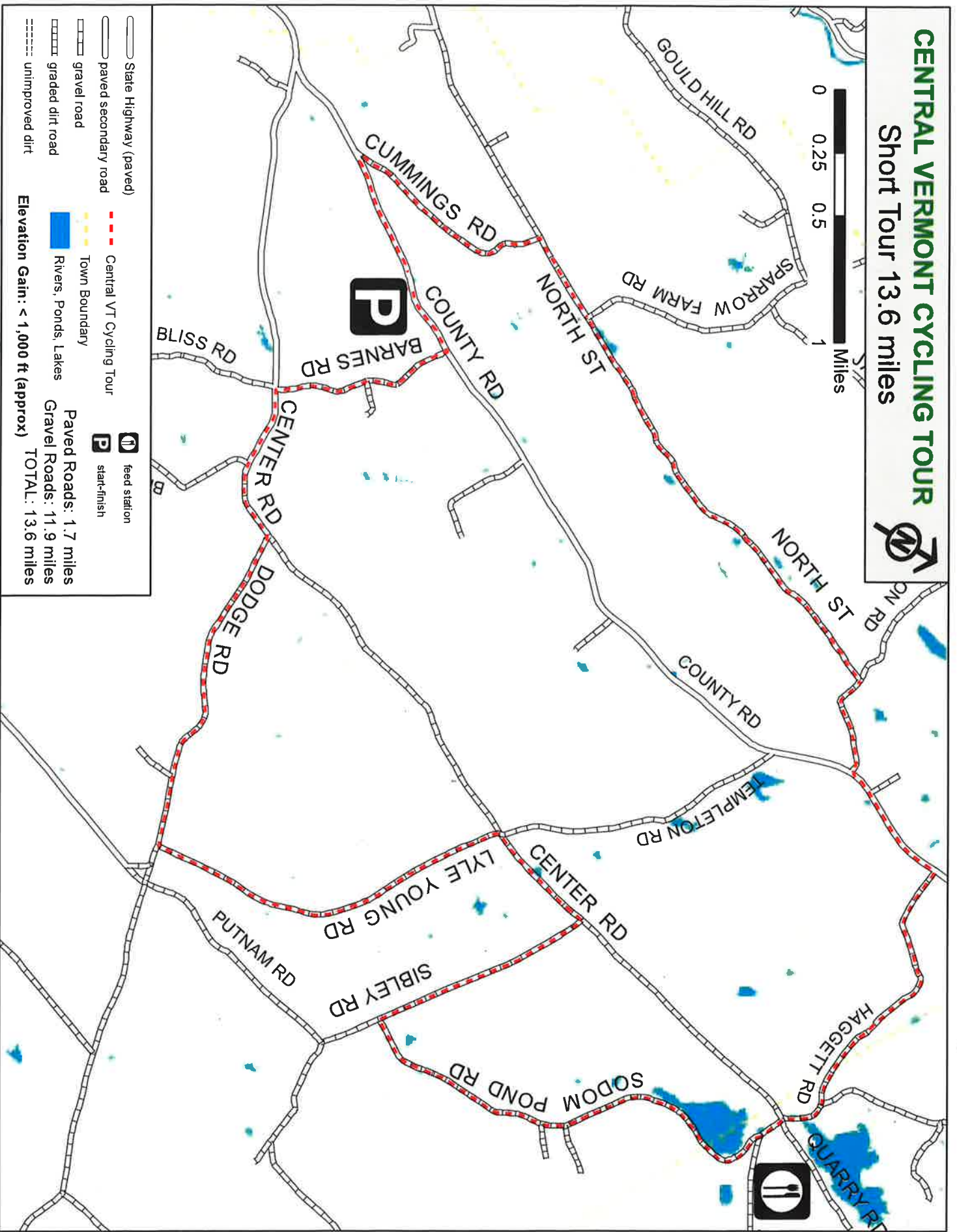

## Short Tour 13.6 miles



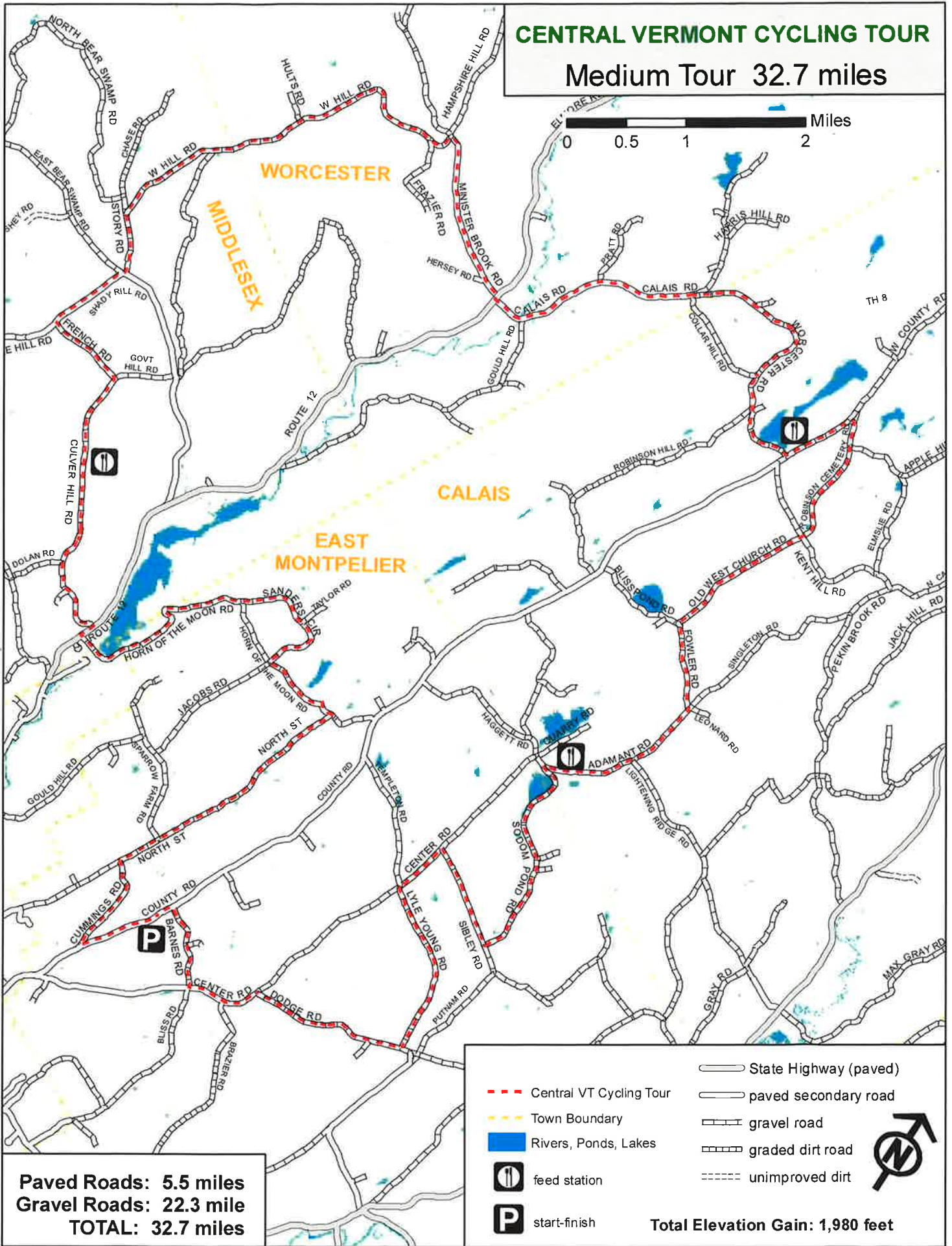

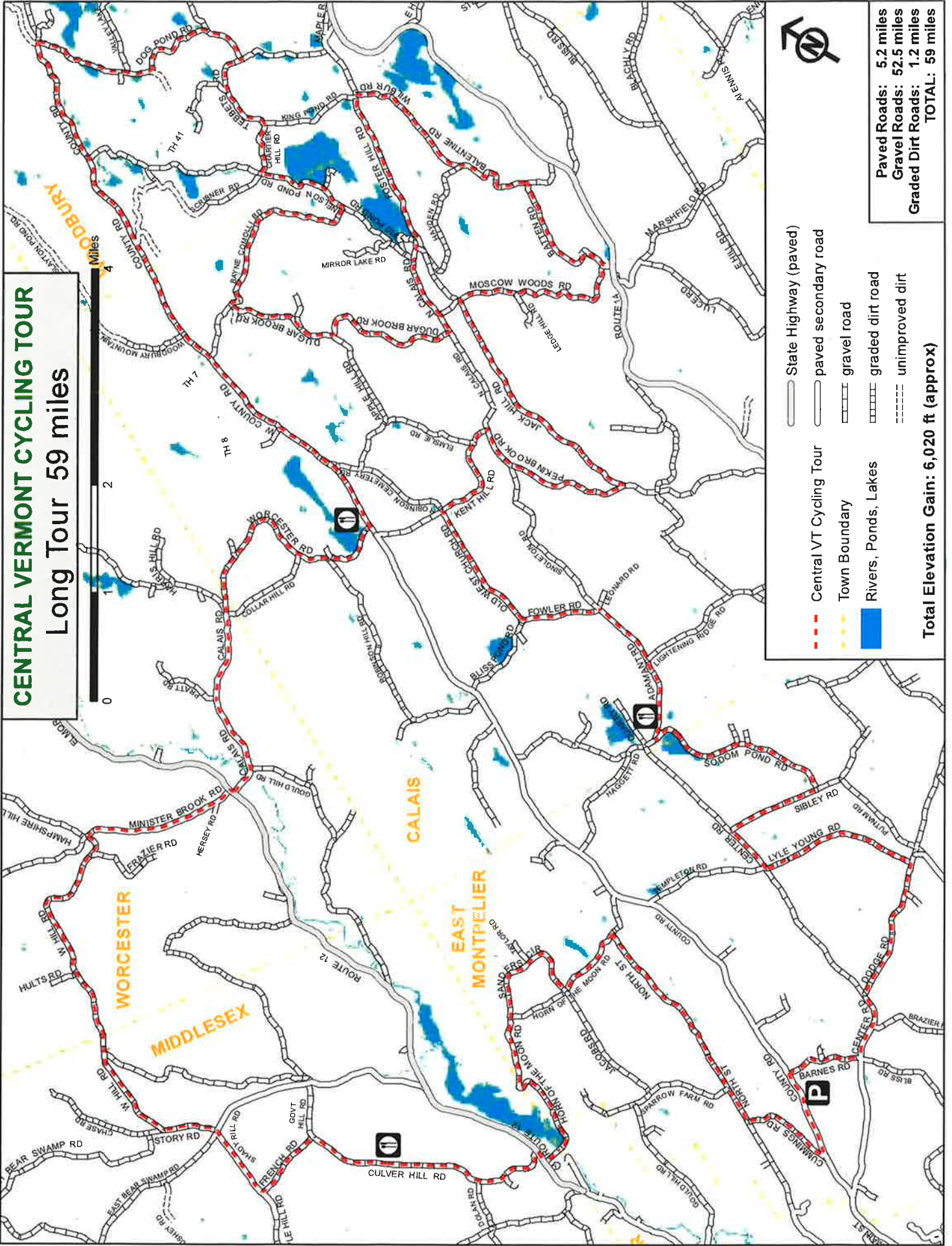

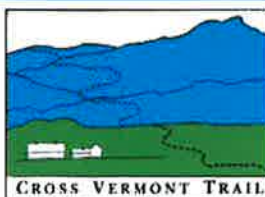
