Dear Selectboard members:

Congratulations and thank you for your recent Town Meeting Day vote to create and join the Central Vermont Internet communications union district! Your constituents and voters in eleven other towns have taken the first step towards getting everyone in Central Vermont gigabit-speed fiber Internet. The second step is now in your hands. 30 V.S.A. § 3059 reads, in part (my emphasis):

Annually on or before the last Monday in April commencing in the year following the effective date of the district's creation, *the legislative body of each member shall appoint a representative and one or more alternates to the governing board for one-year terms.* Appointments of representatives and alternates shall be in writing, signed by the chair of the legislative body of the appointing member, and presented to the clerk of the district. [...]

Absent any district officers, I will temporarily assume the duties of the clerk and will receive your appointment at the address below. I have attached a document which you may use to indicate your appointment, which I must receive via email or mail no later than April 30th, per statute. Note that you may need to make a public announcement of the vacancy before making the appointment.

I also respectfully ask for help (a) locating volunteers in your town who may be willing to serve on committees (technical, fundraising, outreach, etc.), (b) finding businesses interested in subscribing to CVI, and (c) finding individuals and businesses willing to loan or donate money towards getting our initial operations off the ground. Please contact me directly if you have leads on these or any other questions!
