Conditional Use Review - Marc Fontaine

The Chair opened the review at 7:05pm by reading the warning: "Conditional use review of Application #13-033, submitted by Marc Fontaine, to construct a 36' x 90' building to house the existing sawmill on his property located at 628 VT Rte. 14N. This is a mixed use property with a single-family residence and a light industry business. Mr. Fontaine is requesting an amendment to Conditional Use Permit #04-081 (previously amended by Zoning Permit #07-086) which governs the existing commercial sawmill operation. The property is located in Zone D – Rural Residential/Agricultural, for which light industry requires conditional use review." The applicant was sworn in at 7:02pm. The applicant would like to build an enclosed building for his existing sawmill. He will be adding a few more parking spaces, and some additional lighting is proposed along the back of the existing garage. The existing pole barn will be used for lumber storage.
