# Discuss Status &/or Content of Maps for Town Plan

- Will be in color online, black & white for printed copies
- ➤ All maps need to list the data sources
- ➤ Remove reference to Town Forest around U-32 on all maps
- Use same base map for all roads
- Agriculture Land Use different data points from last Town Plan
- ➤ Protected Land remove key A-S; add key with parcels and acreage identified
- Conservation Overlay add river in key; add water/wastewater/surface water
- Significant Habitats OK
- ➤ Wetlands & Waterways OK
- ➤ Well-head Protection Areas move description names off blue areas
- Roads by Functional Class
  - o Check on urban road classification
  - o Typo on Rural Minor
  - o Compare to 2008 version; may not be compatible with Transportation chapter
  - o Does town have its own classification?
  - o Consider simplifying the map
  - o Rural/urban designations not needed
- ➤ E-911 Sites
  - o Mark emergency shelter as U-32
  - o Some roads show as going through even though they don't
  - o Acknowledge source & dates
  - Review commercial farms
- Housing District OK
- East Montpelier Facilities needs a key; add Town Forest on North Street/Baird parcel
- ➤ Historic Sites add note to refer to table/key
- East Montpelier Land Use re-label zoning districts; consider changing colors of districts
