- ➤ Lack of affordable housing
- > Can we hire a town planner consultant?
- ➤ Sewer options 1) connect to Montpelier around U-32, 2) centralized septic in the village
- New map show lots, conserved land, show what's not buildable
 - o show growth areas over the last 10-20 years see how/where growth has actually occurred
- Ms. Potter will get a quote from CVRPC on a build out analysis what would the town look like under the current regs
- Town has many large landowners what happens to the land when they're gone
- > Broad, conceptual discussion
- > Options for development in Village/Gallison Hill area
- > Need a plan for housing/affordable housing for the next Town Plan
- North Montpelier as a potential growth center
