 - o Create village zone
 - o Solutions for wastewater engineering study instead of planning study

- > Sam Anderson with Economic Development Corporation might be worth talking to; she may be able to help determine what is possible
- > Grant application is due September 30, 2015
- > PC should ask RPC prior to August so that the application can be reviewed in September
