Purpose

Uses - Permitted and Conditional

- ➤ Agriculture leave as permitted
- ➤ Community center move to conditional
- ➤ Dwelling, multi-family (max 6) remove from permitted, leave as conditional
- Forestry similar to agriculture, leave as permitted
- > Extraction of resources change to Extraction of groundwater and refer to Section 4.7 only
- ➤ Schools add to conditional
- ➤ Light industry remove from conditional
- ➤ Kennel/vet/telecom look at again at a future meeting

Supplemental Standards

➤ Include PUDs; make sure to review Section 5.6 to include Village Residential Subarea

Update on Town and Regional Energy Planning

The RPC is drafting a regional energy plan and Ms. Potter is on the advisory committee. The three members plus Ms. Potter attended CVRPC's training session and the Energy Committee wants to be one of the three initial towns that are helped by CVRPC but needs the support of the PC. The PC would like to use the enthusiasm of interested citizens and will draft a letter of support. The energy plan should be integrated into the Town Plan.
