Review of Draft Table 2.6 Conservation Overlay District

The PC discussed the need to specify permitted versus conditional uses. Some members feel that Sections B, C and D are redundant, as they are covered under draft Article 9. Section E is the only one not covered elsewhere.

(D) – Water Supply

- > Needs more specifics; defined areas around water supplies
- ➤ Include Well-head Protection Area map

There was some discussion regarding whether an overlay district is needed or not and the PC agreed that it is needed, but sections B and C are probably not needed. There was a proposal to add 'wetland' in the language in Section 3.12 – Waterways and Water Resources. The PC agreed to eliminate sections B & C as long as the language change is made to Section 3.12.

Motion: I move to change Section 3.12 as follows: "Surface Waters and Wetlands. To prevent...surfaces waters and wetlands.

Made: Ms. Potter, second: Mr. Hill **Vote on Motion:** Passed 9-0

(D) Water Supply

Change as follows: "The following uses are prohibited: "Junk Storage...Manure Storage. Permitted uses are agricultural, forestry, accessory dwellings; all other uses shall be conditional uses and need to comply with supplemental district standards in (E)" {old Table 2.6}

(E) – High Elevation

Permitted uses are agricultural and forestry; development over 1500 feet is prohibited.

The Chair will draft new conservation overlay language for review at a future meeting.
