### **CHANGES TO PROPERTY TAXES**

At the 2005 Town Meeting, East Montpelier voters authorized the change of the Town's budgeting year from a calendar year to a fiscal year starting July 1 and ending June 30. Taxes are to be collected in two installments (due November 15 and May 15) as voted annually in the Articles of Warning.
