MUTCD CHAPTER 5B. REGULATORY SIGNS For Low-Volume Roads Section 5B.01 Introduction

Support:

The purpose of a regulatory sign is to inform highway users of traffic laws or regulations, and to indicate the applicability of legal requirements that would not otherwise be apparent.

The provisions for regulatory signs are contained in Chapter 2B and in other Sections of this Manual. Provisions for regulatory signs that are specific to low-volume roads are contained in this Chapter.

Section 5B.02 STOP and YIELD Signs (R1-1 and R1-2)

Guidance:

STOP (R1-1) and YIELD (R1-2) signs (see Figure 5B-1) should be considered for use on low-volume roads where engineering judgment or study, consistent with the provisions of Sections 2B.04 to 2B.10, indicates that either of the following conditions applies:

- A. An intersection of a less-important road with a main road where application of the normal right-of-way rule might not be readily apparent.
- B. An intersection that has restricted sight distance for the prevailing vehicle speeds.

Consideration of 2015 Employee Health Care Benefit Options

- Basic question is whether the board wants to make any changes to current offerings:
 - o We pay the equivalent of 90% of the BCBS Platinum Plan
 - At the time we approved this last year, we thought the employees would have the full range of BCBS plans to choose between; because of the way the health care exchange played out, in the end our employees were all "forced" to take the Platinum Plan
 - o In lieu of insurance, we provide a stipend of \$1,600
- Assuming we want to stick with the BCBS offerings, an initial issue is whether we want to offer our employees access to all 9 BCBS plans or some subset of same (see sheet)
- Cost of BCBS plans are up about 7.1%
- FY2015 budget health insurance line is \$62,000; the first half of the 2015 health care benefit is covered by this budget line, with the second half under the FY2016 budget; current monthly cost (with stipends) is \$4,921.31; projected monthly cost starting in January 2015, using the current benefit and assuming no changes other than the anticipated shift of one employee from single to 2-person, will be \$5,804.17 (absent the employee shift the cost would be \$5,242.41). As always, we have to open up the benefit options to all employees, so the actual cost could be significantly higher.

 - o Town share of insurance cost
 - o BCBS plans to be offered to employees
 - o Value of stipend in lieu of health insurance
