

Upon receipt of a petition for the formation of East Montpelier Fire District #1, submitted to the East Montpelier Select Board in accordance with 20 V.S.A. §2481, at regular meeting held thereof on July 12th, 2010, acknowledge receipt of said Petition and conduct public hearings in to the substance thereof.

Upon motion duly made and adopted, it was RESOLVED BY THE EAST MONTPELIER SELECT BOARD, that

- (1) East Montpelier Fire District #1 is hereby established.
- (2) The geographical limits of said Fire District are identified as:

The boundary starting with parcel 21-51-46 off Cherry Tree Hill Road, going southeast to parcel 21-51-47 on Cherry Tree Hill Road, heading Northeast to terminate at parcel 21-51-7 on Cherry Tree Hill Road. Returning southwest on Cherry Tree Hill Road to parcel 21-51-47, continuing southwest to terminate at parcel 21-51-50 on Cherry Tree Hill Road. Extending southeast from Cherry Tree Hill Road at parcel 21-51-28 to US Route 2 at parcel 21-51-55. Heading southwest to terminate at parcel 21-51-51.1 on US Route 2. Cross US Route 2 at parcel 21-51-53 to include parcels 21-51-60, 21-51-61, 21-51-62, 21-51-63, and 21-51-64, returning to parcel 21-51-55. Continue northeast to VT Route 14 South at parcel 21-52-52, and crossing under the Winooski River, and continuing along VT Route 14 South, terminating at parcel 12-01-40.

Heading north on VT Route 14 South to parcel 12-02-22.021, continuing southwest to include 12-01-15, 12-01-16, 12-01-17, 12-01-18, 12-01-19, and 12-01-3. Crossing parcel 12-33-01 to 12-01-37.11, on Route 14 South. At parcel 12-02-20.2, heading easterly and terminating at 12-02-19.111 and 12-02-19.13. Cross VT Route 14 South at parcel 12-02-1 to include parcels 12-01-7, 12-01-8, 12-01-3, 12-01-4 and 12-01-5.

At parcel 12-02-3 at VT Route 14 South and Carleton Boulevard, continuing around Carleton Boulevard, around Pauls Square, and returning to VT Route 14 South at parcel 21-52-65.

Crossing VT Route 14 South at parcel 21-52-66 to include 21-51-68.2, 21-51-68.1, and 21-51-68.3.

At parcel 21-51-52 heading northeasterly direction along US Route 2 East, terminating at parcel 21-51-43 on US Route 2. From parcel 21-52-38 on US Route 2, crossing US Route 2 and continuing north on VT Route 14 North to terminate at parcel 21-52-14.111 and parcel 21-52-12.

At parcel 21-52-33 on VT Route 14 North, heading north on Kelton Road terminating at parcel 21-52-10.1 on Kelton Road.

At parcel 21-52-34 on VT Route 14 North, crossing VT Route 14 North, proceeding northwest and terminating at parcel 21-51-32 on Quaker Road. On Quaker Road at parcel 21-51-33 to include 21-51-38.2, 21-51-38.1, and 21-51-39. At parcel 21-51-33, crossing Quaker Road to include parcels 21-52-27, 21-52-20, 21-52-28, and 21-52-29.

- (3) All property within the limits of the Fire District shall be subject to the provisions of 20 V.S.A. Ch. 171, Subchs. 1 and 3, and the inhabitants thereof shall be a body corporate for all purposes permitted by law.
- (4) The Fire District shall have those powers and prerogatives enumerated in 20 V.S.A. §2482-2488, 2601 and 2607, together with those powers conferred generally upon municipal corporations incident to ownership, acquisition and management of water works.
- (5) The Select Board reserves the right to modify the boundaries of the Fire District within sixty (60) days of the date of this Certificate, which modification shall take form of an amendment here to referencing a survey of plan depicting boundaries. Upon expiration of such sixty (60) day period, the boundaries of the Fire District shall be deemed to have been conclusively established, and thereafter may be modified only as provided by statute.
- (6) The first meeting of the East Montpelier Fire District #1 is hereby called for August 16th, 2010 at the East Montpelier Town Offices, for the purpose of transacting the following Articles of business:
 - a. To appoint a moderator for this first meeting
 - To elect a District Clerk, a District Treasurer, a District Collector, and three Prudential Committee members to serve for terms of one, two and three years respectively.
 - c. To establish the date of the annual meeting.
 - d. To discuss any other matter with may properly come before the meeting.

A member of the East Montpelier Select Board shall preside at the first meeting of the Fire District. Notice thereof shall be given by posting the Warning in at least three public places within the Fire District, and publishing the Warning once in the Times Argus. Such posting, publication and delivery shall occur no more than 40 nor less than 30 days before the date of said first meeting of the Fire District. The Warning for said meeting shall contain a notice to the effect that persons residing within the Fire District who are voters in Town Meeting shall be voters of the Fire District.
