East Montpelier Hazard Mitigation Plan Development

Jonathan DeLaBruere, CVRPC Assistant Planner East Montpelier Emergency Management Committee

• Mr. DeLaBruere will provide an update on the hazard mitigation plan update process, give a synopsis of our hazard mitigation survey results, and lead a discussion on the assessment of and prioritization of hazards affecting East Montpelier

Consideration of Appointment to Planning Commission [Potential Executive Session]

• The Planning Commission recommends Siu Tip Lam to fill the vacancy created by Ray Stout's recent resignation; the appointment will be for the final year of Ray's term, to 2020 Town Meeting

Discussion on Creation of Cemetery Committee

- Now that the town voters have returned responsibility for cemetery management to the Selectboard, the board needs to decide how to arrange for the management; the general thought has been to create a Cemetery Committee to handle operations with oversight by the Selectboard; it appears 4 of the former commission members would like to be on the new committee (Elliott Morse, Tim Lamson, Jon Boucher, and Emily Goyette); the first question for committee creation is how many members are desired (5, 7, 9...); a second central question is will there be a sexton and, if so, how will the sexton be appointed/paid (perhaps committee recommends; board appoints; town employee essentially the ZA model); there has been some chatter about stipends for the committee members; job descriptions for sexton and cemetery workers should be developed
- An important side issue is the actual use of the cemeteries; Jon Boucher will have some information on using an outside contractor for burials, with oversight by the sexton

<u>Discussion on Reconfiguration of Revolving Loan Advisory Committee and Consideration of Revolving Loan Fund Policies & Procedures</u>

• This item should be tabled until we receive a response from the VT Agency of Commerce & Community Development regarding the proposed shift to a Selectboard/Advisor model

Discussion on Development of Social Media Policy

• In light of the Recreation Board's desire for guidance on if/how town committees should utilize social media, the board decided at its February 18th meeting to review the model VLCT social media policy and bring the issue up at a later meeting to determine whether to move forward with development of a town social media policy

Consideration of rbTechnologies Quote for Town Office Network Infrastructure Upgrade Project

- The town office network is in need of a complete infrastructure overhaul; this has been in the works for over two years; no new equipment has been purchased (other than necessary items to prolong the productivity of the existing setup) with the expectation that once Windows 7 became obsolete (Windows 7 Pro, our operating system, sunsets January 25, 2020), everything would be replaced, including the servers and work stations; we will move to Office 365, which will enable a shift to email addresses with @eastmontpeliervt.org
- Our IT provider, rbTechnologies, an East Montpelier company, has provided a quote of \$32,421 for the new hardware/software plus installation; target time period for installation is early-to-mid fall 2019; if willing to accept quote, board should authorize TA Johnson to complete; upfront payment of hardware cost (\$20,086) is expected and would be on the next board warrant

2019 Selectboard Organization

- At a minimum, board needs to elect a chair and vice-chair
- Should also authorize a member to sign payroll warrants, payroll vendor warrants, and necessary expense warrants (when due dates don't align with meeting dates; rarely happens)

Town Administrator Report

- Blake/Allard Tax Sale Update:
 - o The March 7th tax sale of the 2784 US Rte. 2 parcel generated one bid; Richard Schiller of Colchester was the successful bidder at \$20,000, above the minimum of \$18,208.68
- East Montpelier Stormwater Master Plan Update:
 - The draft final report for the CVRPC-led project should be delivered by early April;
 CVRPC's Pam DeAndrea and possibly Watershed Consulting Associates (the lead firm doing the plan) personnel will present the report to the Selectboard at the April 22nd board meeting
- Special School Meeting Australian Ballot Update:
 - O Vote set for April 9th, 7 to 7 in EMES library; the U-32 ballot (3 items including budget) result will be a merged vote by tabulator at the WCSU office (Berlin tabulator); the EMES ballot (budget only) will be hand counted by BCA after vote at EMES
