Tuesday, March 3, 2020

Town Forum: **Saturday, February 29, 2020, 9:30 a.m., East Montpelier Elementary School gym.** This will be your only opportunity to discuss town warning articles, including the budget items that are to be voted on by Australian Ballot. The candidates for offices will be introduced. Remember to bring your copy of the Town Report.

School Hearing: A public hearing will take place at **U-32, Room 128/131 at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, March 2, 2020** to provide information on the articles to be voted by Australian Ballot at the municipalities' respective Town Meetings on Tuesday, March 3, 2020.

Town Meeting Day: **Tuesday, March 3, 2020, 9:30 a.m. at East Montpelier Elementary School.** The Town Meeting is warned for 9:30 a.m. Meeting.

Australian Ballot: **Tuesday, March 3, 2020 at East Montpelier Elementary School.** POLLS are open 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Location: East Montpelier Elementary School at 665 Vincent Flats Road, East Montpelier, Vermont

Checklist Posted: The current checklist is attached to this posting. Please make sure your name is on it if you are a resident. If not, please register to vote.

Voter Registration: You may register to vote in the upcoming Town Meeting at the Town Office during regular office hours, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Thursday, and Friday, 9 a.m. to noon or online at <https://mvp.sec.state.vt.us/>. Same day registration at the polls is also available.

Early or Absentee Voting: Call the Town Clerk's Office at 223-3313 x 202 or go to the office to obtain ballots. All ballots must be returned to the Town Clerk by 7:00 p.m. Town Meeting Day to be counted. The Town Office will **not** be open on Town Meeting Day. **If returning your absentee ballot in person on Town Meeting Day, please deliver it to the East Montpelier Elementary School before 7:00 p.m.**

WAYS TO VOTE ABSENTEE:

Before Town Meeting Day:

- 1) You can pick up a ballot and return it at the Town Office.
- 2) Have a ballot mailed to you, and mail or bring it back prior to close of business March 2nd.
- 3) Vote in the Town Clerk's Office until the office closes at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, March 2nd.

On Town Meeting Day:

- 4) You can submit sealed ballots at EMES before the polls close at 7:00 p.m.
- 5) If sick or disabled, two Justices of the Peace can bring a ballot to you at your home on any of the eight days preceding the day of the election or on the day of election.
