

# NOTICE TO VOTERS

## EARLY TABULATION OF BALLOTS

The Board of Civil Authority met on Monday, September 28, 2020 and voted to feed ballots duly received at the Town Offices from early voters in the 2020 General Election into the tabulator.

These proceedings will occur weekly on Thursday afternoons at 4:00 p.m. beginning on Thursday, October 15, 2020. Ballots will be fed into the tabulator until all ballots are tabulated or until 5:30 p.m., whichever happens first. The process will be live streamed via zoom and performed by at least three members of the Board of Civil Authority.

**Early or Absentee Voting:** Call the Town Clerk's Office at 223-3313 x 202 to obtain ballots. All ballots must be returned to the Town Clerk by 7:00 p.m. Primary Election Day to be counted. The Town Office will **not** be open to the public on Primary Election Day. **If returning your absentee ballot in person on Town Meeting Day, please deliver it to the East Montpelier Elementary School before 7:00 p.m.**

### **Ways to Return your General Election Ballot**

- 1) Place your voted ballot into the enclosed mailing envelope and mail it back prior to close of business Monday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- 2) Drop your ballot off at the blue drop box located at the Town Office at 40 Kelton Road.
- 3) Bring your voted ballot to the East Montpelier Elementary School on Tuesday, November 3.
