<u>Checklist Posted</u>: The current checklist is attached to this posting. Please make sure your name is on it if you are a resident. If not, please register to vote.

<u>Voter Registration</u>: You may register to vote in the upcoming Town Meeting at the Town Office during regular office hours, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Thursday, and Friday, 9 a.m. to noon or online at https://mvp.sec.state.vt.us/. Same day registration at the polls is also available.

<u>Early or Absentee Voting</u>: All active registered voters will receive ballots by mail no later than February 16. All ballots must be returned to the Town Clerk by 7:00 p.m. Town Meeting Day to be counted. The Town Office will <u>not</u> be open on Town Meeting Day. If returning your absentee ballot in person on Town Meeting Day, please deliver it to the East Montpelier Elementary School before 7:00 p.m.

WAYS TO VOTE ABSENTEE:

Before Town Meeting Day:

- 1) All active voters will be mailed a ballot no later than February 16, 2021.
- 2) If you do not receive a ballot by mail, contact the Town Clerk's office to have one mailed to you or to pick one up. Please mail or bring it back prior to close of business March 1sth.
- 3) Mail or drop your ballot in the secure outdoor ballot box at the Town Clerk's Office until the office closes at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, March 1st.

On Town Meeting Day:

- 4) You can submit sealed ballots at EMES before the polls close at 7:00 p.m.
- 5) If sick or disabled, two Justices of the Peace can bring a ballot to you at your home on any of the eight days preceding the day of the election or on the day of election.
