### **Discussion on Renewable Energy Conversions of Municipal Buildings**

Mr. Etnier related a conversation he had with State Senator Andy Perchlik regarding programs for shifting heating infrastructure away from fossil fuel use at town facilities. H.518, setting up the Municipal Energy Resilience Program, has now passed the House and is in Senate committee review. Mr. Etnier further noted that there is a potential anonymous donor willing to put up \$5,000 towards a fuel switching effort. Board members agreed that this topic is an important one to stay on top of as the bill moves forward.
