December 1, 2025: Additional EECBG funding available!

The Department of Public Service currently has **\$43,019.26** in unobligated EECBG funds available and we are looking to distribute these funds to municipalities with executed grant agreements to stay in compliance with our DOE obligation requirements.

Municipalities may request **a portion of** or **the full amount** of the remaining funds. To be considered for a supplemental award, please reply to this email by Friday, January 16, 2026 with a Word document that includes the following information:

1. The specific budgeted activities in your existing grant agreement that would be supplemented with this funding **OR** your proposed NEW activity, that falls within the scope of allowed activities (see original RFP).
2. The amount of supplemental funds requested and activities to be completed. (NOTE: Any new activities should still fall under the categories/activities included in the last RFP – attached)
The minimum amount that would still meaningfully advance your project objectives (in case total requests exceed available funds)
The outcomes you anticipate achieving with the supplemental funding.

These funds will be distributed as amendments to existing grants.
